

## **MOMA CODE OF ETHICS**

September 18, 1987

Pursuant to the Resolution adopted by the Board of Directors of the Minnesota Operators of Music and Amusements on this date the following Code of Ethics shall govern the conduct of all members or applicants for membership in MOMA. Acceptance of membership in MOMA or the renewal of membership by a current member of MOMA represents the acceptance by the applicant or member of this Code of Ethics.

1. MOMA members shall not engage in illegal activity or in conduct involving dishonesty, fraud, deceit or misrepresentation.
2. Applicants for MOMA membership shall not make a material false statement nor intentionally fail to disclose a material fact in connection with the application for membership in MOMA, nor shall a member further the application for membership of any person or entity who is known to be unqualified for membership.
3. Direct sales by a Manufacturer, Distributor or Operator to a location of coin-operated amusement devices is declared to be contrary to the best interests of MOMA and its members. Such sales are hereby declared to be in violation of this Code of Ethics.

A violation of this Code of Ethics subjects a member to suspension or expulsion from membership in MOMA pursuant to Article 1D of the By-laws of the MOMA subject to the procedures set forth in paragraph D. This Code of Ethics is declared to be a rule of the association within the meaning of that term in Article 1D.
